

55 Hudson Yards – New York, NY

A Twist On Early Modernism, Complete with a Swisspearl Rainscreen



The unique façade of 55 Hudson Yards was inspired by the revitalized High Line district, the manufactured cast iron façades of the Soho buildings and the best of early modernism. It was designed by A. Eugene Kohn and Kohn Pedersen Fox Associates (KPF). With 1.3-millionsquare-foot office space this twist on modernism is located at the intersection of Hudson Yards, the High Line and Hudson Park & Boulevard.
