

The \$57 million modernization of John Eaton Elementary School in Washington, DC was completed by Sigal Grunley Joint Venture in collaboration with CSG (Cox Graae and Spack) Architects. A key feature of the design is the use of grooved Terra5 terracotta rainscreen panels, selected to enhance the modern façade while complementing traditional brick masonry. The 50,459 SF addition supports expanded capacity for up to 490 students, including new academic wings, a cafeteria, kitchen, and administrative areas. The project carefully balanced historic preservation with the integration of new space and maintained valuable outdoor areas for student use.
