The \$57 million modernization project included a 50,459 SF addition, which has helped this elementary school accommodate up to 490 students with new academic areas, cafeteria, kitchen, and administrative spaces. CGS selected Terra5 Terracotta Rainscreen panels with a unique grooved pattern to complement the elements of this modern façade addition. The terracotta rainscreen portions blend well with the use of traditional brick masonry on this application.
